What is Narcan?

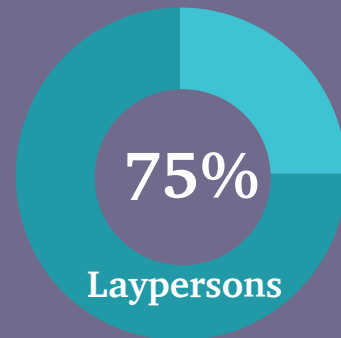
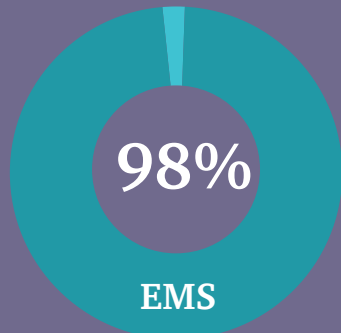
Naloxone (Narcan) is an FDA-approved medication that reverses the effects of an opioid overdose.

“Harm reduction is a set of practical strategies and ideas aimed at reducing negative consequences associated with drug use. [It] is also a movement for social justice built on a belief in, and respect for, the rights of people who use drugs.”

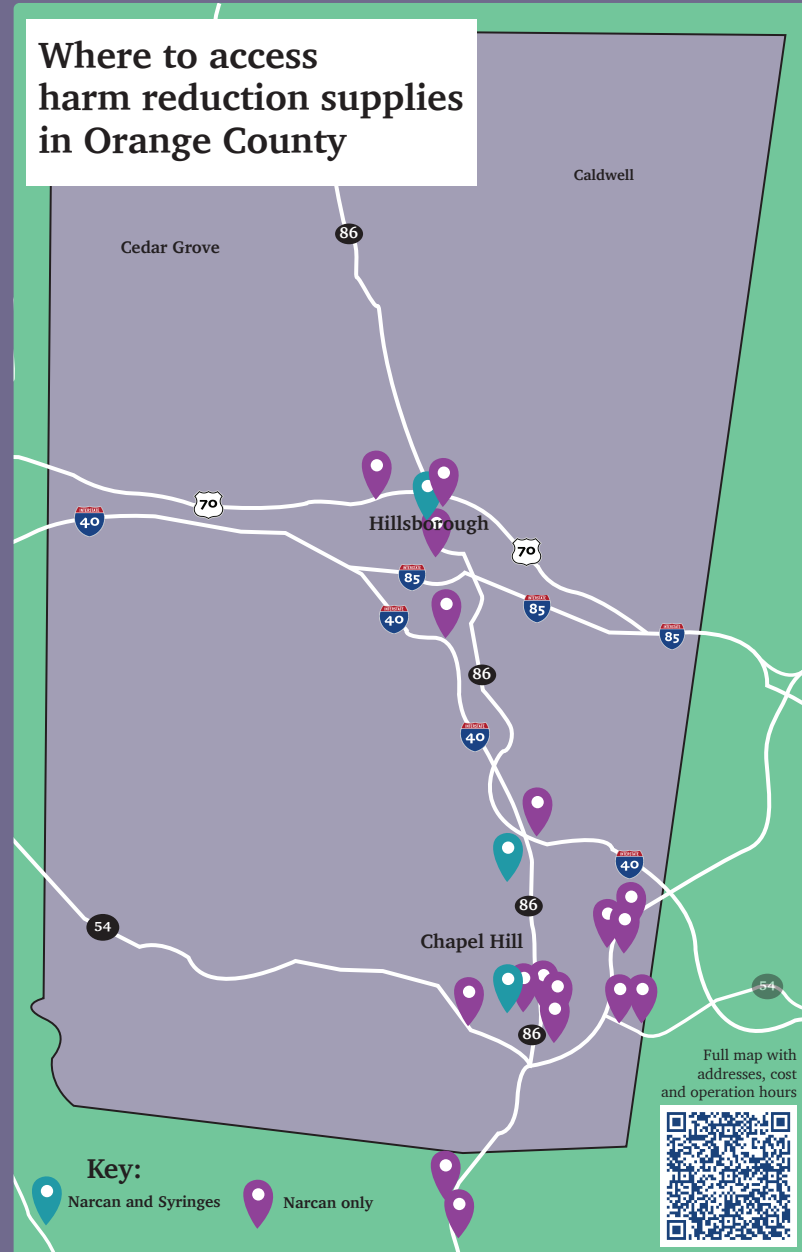
Syringe Service Programs (SSPs)

SSPs distribute sterile syringes, safer drug use supplies and education to people who inject drugs.

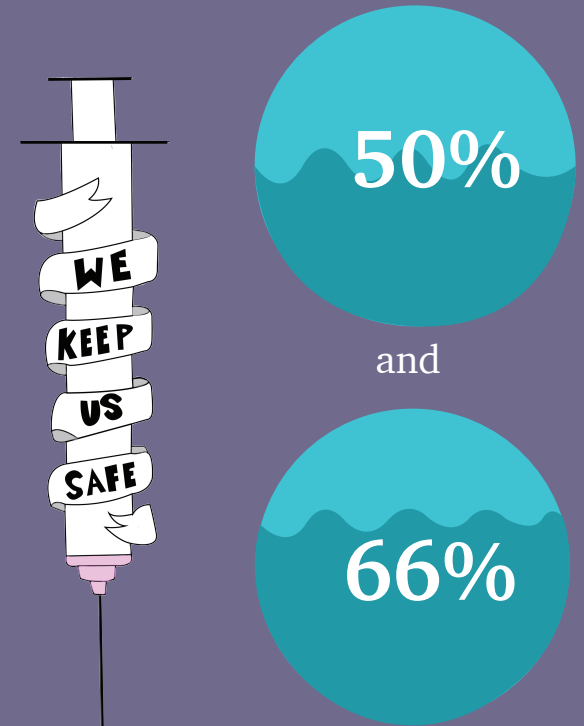
Efficacy of Narcan in opioid overdose reversal when administered by:
